## Given Recipe - Chocolate & Beetroot Cake

3 Eggs	180g Plain flour
200ml Veg oil	2tsp Baking powder
1 tsp Vanilla essence	250g Beetroot, cooked & roughly grated
75g Cocoa powder	Icing Sugar

### Method

Preheat the oven to 160c /gas mark 2.5

Mix the egg, sugar & oil in a bowl with whisk until the sugar has dissolved. Sift the dry into the mix followed by the beetroot. Put the mix in the greased cake tin & spread even over for 50-60 Mins, then skewer it with a knife, if it comes out clean, the cake is ready. Leave to cool on a rack at room temperature. Dust with icing sugar.

- 1, Competitions open to all WRI members in Show Area.
- 2, An entry of 10p for each lable and only one entry in each class and 50p for Community Work
- 3, Every entry must be competitors own work. All work to have been completed since last show. Note - Community items of last year's show may be entered in this year's show.
- 4, Exhibits must put full name and name of Institute (concealed) on exhibit lables and all lables must be firmly attached to exhibits, no name - no points.
- 5, Exhibits will not be accepted in Tent after 9.30 am.
- 6, No entries will be accepted unlabelled at the tent, and lables will not be sold in the tent in the morning.
